Safety Concerns

We have been noticing some safety concerns recently, so we wanted to give out a few reminders to ensure the safety of all children.

- No toys should be brought into the school from home unless prior authorization from their child's teacher is given.
- Parents should not leave any children unattended in vehicle at drop-off or pickup.
- Parents must check children in and out every day, and must walk their child to their classroom.
- It is highly recommended that children's rings, bracelets, necklaces etc. not be worn to school for safety reasons.
